



50 PLANNED GIFTS

As SLCS celebrates 50 years of land conservation in the Squam Lakes Watershed we are launching a new initiative to insure success in stewarding our protected lands forever. Together we have already protected 22% of the watershed, with the goal of protecting 33%. Stewarding ten thousand plus acres of land requires more than the many hours of annual site work done by our dedicated volunteers. It requires regular communication with landowners, thorough record keeping and extensive documentation by professional staff.

With this challenge in mind, our goal is to identify 50 friends of SLCS who would consider naming SLCS in their estate plan. We have a Planned Giving Policy and are prepared to review options with participants. Raising funds for operations is difficult for organizations. A planned gift to SLCS will ensure resources are available to steward the land we have all dedicated ourselves to protect.
